

Corymbia gummifera

Red Bloodwood

Description

Native Eucalypt with scaly dark grey bark and creamy white flowers in summer to autumn

Size

Tall native tree with narrow to rounded canopy

Maximum height: 15 to 20 metres

Maximum spread: 6 to 8 metres

Features

Handsome tree when in bloom with the white flowers contrasting with the very dark bark.

Uses

- Drought and fairly coastal tolerant
- Food source for birds and insects
- Tolerates poor soils

Preferred conditions

Open to sunny position. Prefers poor sandstone soils but will tolerate heavier clay soils

Availability

Native nurseries.
