CONDITIONS OF ISSUE

A Residential Preferential Parking Scheme operates in parts of Bondi Junction, Bondi Beach, Bronte, Charing Cross and Queens Park.

Temporary permits must be applied for by the resident and may be issued in the following circumstances:

- where the resident’s vehicle is not registered in their name or address. Permits may be issued consecutively
- to visiting / borrowed / hired vehicles
- to a tradesperson’s vehicle for the duration of work, up to two months. Note, these permits are not available for tradespersons at commercial / investment properties.

We cannot issue parking permits to a non-resident even if they operate a business in the Waverley area or are a Waverley Council ratepayer.

Permits will only be issued to registered motor vehicles less than four and a half tonnes GVM. Valid vehicle registration papers must be presented at time of permit application. Permits are also available for light registered trailers (eg box, caravan and boat trailers)

Temporary permits are offered on condition that the applicant does not have adequate off-street parking. Permits will not be issued where the applicant has rendered available off-street parking unavailable through change of use or granting usage to a third party. Residents of buildings constructed under development approval granted after 30 June 2002 are not eligible for parking permits.

Temporary Parking Permits cannot be replaced if lost or stolen. Reapplication for lost or stolen permits will attract the full fee payable.

Fees are correct until 30 June 2012. Fees are subject to change after this date.

Council may vary conditions of the issue and use of permits.

CONDITIONS OF USE

A permit entitles the holder to unrestricted parking only where signs state “Permit Holders Excepted” together with the area number to which your permit applies. Aside from this sole exemption, permits do not provide any right to park a vehicle contrary to the Australian Road Rules (eg parking in Disabled Parking areas or at expired meters in commercial areas).

The issue of a permit does not guarantee the availability of a parking space to the holder.

Permits must be displayed on the passenger side of the vehicle as near as practicable to the registration label and in such a manner as to be readily visible from outside the vehicle. If displaying the permit on the windscreen, ensure the permit is displayed away from the tinted area.

It is the responsibility of the resident to renew the temporary permit. Reminders will not be issued.

A permit may only be used on the nominated vehicle. Permits are not transferable.

In the event of relocation to another residence, the disposal/sale of the nominated vehicle, or off-street parking at the residence becoming available the permit must be returned to Waverley Council immediately.

The permit may be revoked by members of the Police Service or by an Authorised Council Officer should there be any breach of these conditions. Waverley Council may withdraw permits at its discretion.

Council may vary conditions of the issue of permits.

No fee is refundable once a permit is issued.

Any changes to an existing permit will incur a fee of \$37.50.

The following constitute an offence in a permit parking space or area:

- parking without a permit for longer than the period (time limit) shown on the signs
- the fraudulent use of permits
- use of permits not applicable to the area
- use of defaced, “scratched” or wrongly displayed permits which cannot be read from outside the vehicle by an authorised officer
- use of an expired permit
- use of a permit not applicable to the vehicle or address.

Making a false or misleading statement within this application is an offence.

PRIVACY: The personal information supplied on this form is required in order to provide the service requested.
