The team are scheduled to visit each ward for a 2 week block. While in a ward, Council will tend to any routine tree requests and then systematically work through the area to provide Waverley's LGA with healthy, safe trees. Priority is given to main roads, streets with schools and bus stops and business areas.

### What will be addressed?

During any pruning, the following will be taken into consideration:

- · Pedestrian access to 2.5m (height)
- Vehicular access
- Traffic sightlines
- · Powerline clearance
- Signage
- Lighting
- Crown thinning (to allow for better growth and air flow)
- Tree health and vigor
- Deadwood > 50mm
- · Pests and disease
- Arboriculture defects, inclusions, codominant stems
