

# *Araucaria columnaris*

## Cook Island Pine

---

### Description

Narrow conical tree suitable for frontline coastal areas. Similar to Norfolk Island Pine but columnar and not pyramidal in shape

### Size

Large size

Maximum height: 20 to 30 metres

Maximum spread: 5 to 7 metres

### Features

- Formal shape with dense foliage
- Used extensively in early 20<sup>th</sup> C plantings
- Young specimens may grow at an angle until self correcting to an upright form

### Uses

- Feature tree
- Suitable for frontline coastal zones

### Preferred conditions

Full sun. Adaptable to most soils.  
Prefers moisture.

### Availability

Specialist native nurseries
