Most buses are designated or prioritised for specific community uses, Community Transport for HACC funded services, other services for their use first. Contact each service for availability and appropriateness of buses for your community group or service. Any bus/van with more than 12 seats, the driver must have at least a LR vehicle licence to drive. Information is correct as of **1 August 2007**, contact services for updated information.

Council Buses:

City of Sydney - Community Bus Scheme – Buses available for community based services serving City of Sydney, either for half or full day use, varied costs, minimum LR license needed for drivers.

Community Transport Schemes:

Randwick/Waverley Community Transport – 2 x 20 seater coaster buses & 1 x 12 seater commuter bus. . Charges are \$80 per day for non-profit groups and schools or \$60 per half day. There is also a \$100 deposit for new groups and a \$22 administration fee. Drivers are available for \$30 per hour for a minimum of 3 hours. As this is a HACC funded service, HACC funded programs get priority.

Holdsworth Street Community Centre – has 2 x 24 seater Delux Buses (1 with 2 wheelchair accessory), 1 x 21 seater coaster bus, and 1 x 12 seater (or 11 with wheelchair accessory) sprinter bus. Only authorised community groups or individuals performing community work can use these HSCC-CT vehicles and driver must be at least 25 years old. General fees for use is \$0.90 per km for Woollahra Council funded services (min 50km) and \$1.00 per km for other not profit groups (min 55km).

South East Neighbourhood Centre – has 2 x 18 seater Coaster buses and 1 x 12 seater commuter bus. Fees for Coaster buses are \$100 per day within 80km radius and \$120 per day for outside 80km radius for community groups. For the commuter

bus, fees are \$60 & \$70 for same distances as above.

Cost is \$75 per day for non profit community groups and \$100 per day for other groups. Fuel for up to 50kms is free. LR or equivalent required for use.
