Cheese Tree

Description

Fast growing bushy native tree with glossy green leaves and small cheese-shaped fruit in summer that resemble miniature cheeses but are not edible

Size

Small to medium size tree or large shrub

Maximum height: 5 to 7 metres

Maximum spread: 3 to 5 metres

Features

- Useful small tree to large shrub
- Fast growing when given adequate moisture.

Uses

- Screening tree
- Spreading crown for shade
- Food source for a variety of birds

Preferred conditions

Full sun to partial shade. Adaptable to most soils. Prefers moisture and part shade.
