

Syzygium luehmannii

Riberry

Description

Attractive densely foliated tree with glossy green leaves. Pink new growth and edible fruit.

Size

Medium native tree

Maximum height: 6 to 8 metres

Maximum spread: 4 to 6 metres

Features

- Fast growing with a dense habit when young gradually becoming a single trunked tree
- Clusters of white flowers in spring followed by small red fruits



Uses

- Dense screening tree
- Fruit used for jam making
- Bird attracting

Preferred conditions

Full sun to partial shade. Adaptable to most soils. Prefers moisture.
