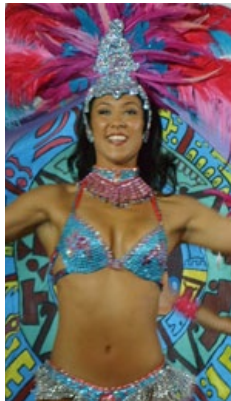

Opening night Wed 29 Feb 6-8pm Simon will be filling the Pavilion Courtyard with classic burnout cars for your visual delight.



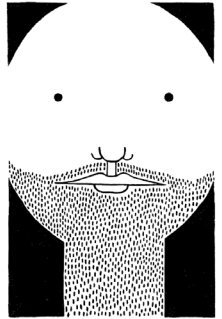

He surrenders his work to simplicity, breaking imagery down to clean organic lines and forms, getting to the essence of the idea.
