Coastal Wattle

Description

Frontline coastal shrub.
Attractive pale yellow flowers
in late winter, early spring

Size

Sprawling shrub to small tree

Maximum height: 0.5 to 3
metres

Maximum spread: 2 to 4
metres



Features

- Useful large shrub to small tree
- Fast growing and can form a protective hedge but can be short lived

Uses

- Dense screening
- Suitable for exposed coastal sites
- Habitat for birds

Preferred conditions

Full sun to partial shade.
Adaptable to most soils. Prefers
moisture.
