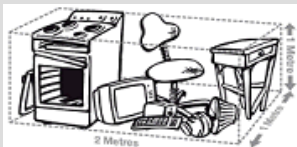

Did you know?

Each household in Waverley can get two FREE 'Your Call' collections of household items each calendar year, ring 9369 8080. Just call 8 days ahead to make the booking. Your items should be placed on the kerbside 24 hours prior to collection. There is also one FREE scheduled annual Council pick up. To view your Council pick-up day, check our website. Limit your items to 2m³ (one trailer load).



E-waste collection A lot of illegally dumped items are electrical goods (e-waste) such as televisions, mobiles, and computers. These items can be recycled for FREE at Council's e-waste collection days. The next collection day is being held on: **Sunday 25 May 2014, 9am to 3pm Lyne Park Car Park, Rose Bay** - entry via Vickery Ave off New South Head Rd.
