

Teachers Beach Parking Permit - FAQs

What is a Teachers Beach Parking Permit?

The Teachers Beach Parking Permit is available to eligible teachers for \$450 for 12 months. The permit allows eligible teachers at schools within Waverley to park their vehicles in Queen Elizabeth Drive and Park Drive North at Bondi Beach between the hours of **7.30am to 6pm Monday–Friday during school terms**. It cannot be used on weekends and public holidays or during school holidays.

Why was this permit introduced?

A resolution was passed by Council at the meeting on 15 May 2018 to introduce a new category of Beach Parking Permit for teachers for a trial period of 12 months. The permit is intended to assist teachers to park during school hours in recognition of their value to the community.

Who can apply?

The Teachers Beach Parking Permit is available to eligible teachers at all schools within Waverley who drive a vehicle registered in their name or company name. The application form must be signed by the nominated administrator for the school.

Will this make it more difficult to park at the beach?

The permit will allow teachers to park their vehicles in Queen Elizabeth Drive and Park Drive North at Bondi Beach between the hours of **7.30am to 6pm Monday–Friday during school terms**. It does not apply on weekends and public holidays or during school holidays so is expected to have minimal impact on parking availability at Bondi Beach.



A limit has been placed on the total number of parking permits issued to teachers in each school in consultation with the school.

Were residents informed of the new permit?

The proposed change to the 2017/28 Fees and Charges was placed on public exhibition for 28 days in April 2018. It was advertised on the Council website with the community invited to submit feedback. Council received 250 submissions with 243 in support of the new permit.
