### Why choose Road to IELTS?

- Starting out: The four eBooks for Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening show you all the different question types. They also tell you exactly what the examiner is looking for.
- Advice and tutorial videos: 17 videos by British Council IELTS experts are packed with tips and tricks for your preparation, and for the test day itself.
- Practice zone: The best chance of achieving the band score you need by practising question and task types in the Practice Zone. It has over 300 interactive activities modelled on real IELTS test papers with instant marking and feedback.
- Test practice: candidates simulate the test experience with three full mock tests in each of the **Reading**, **Writing** and **Listening** papers.

To use Road to IELTS on computers or tablet devices, first set up an account:


- Enter the login page on your computer or computer at the Waverley library site

- Create a new Road to IELTS account by entering your email address and a password at the login page






### **Using Road to IELTS**


- Login
- Click on one of the 4 skill areas then click Starting Out

- Keep track of your time, see how far you have to go, reflect on how far you've come







### Road to IELTS allows you to


- Practice IELTS listening tasks under timed conditions
