23 November 2022	<p>Motion 1:</p> <p>Regarding the recent No Parking signage East Mason Lane off Jackaman Street residents are not happy.</p> <p>Residents would like to decision to be reviewed and revoked with community consultation of affected residents.</p>	<p>Council's Manager of Traffic and Transport has advised that No Parking restrictions were installed in Mason Lane following representations from a resident unable to access parking off Mason Lane.</p> <p>As Mason Lane is only 4 metres wide, it cannot accommodate parked cars.</p>	Planning, Sustainability and Compliance	Complete
23 November 2022	<p>Motion 2:</p> <p>Could Council investigate and respond to the issue of alternative options that restrict and remove boat trailers and other trailers that are currently taking up limited parking spaces in our neighbourhood roads. For example, Council hiring a parking lot specifically for trailers and boats in order to remove their existence in residential neighbourhoods with limited parking.</p>	<p>Council's Manager of Traffic and Transport has advised that boat trailers and trailers in general are an ongoing issue in high density neighbourhoods.</p> <p>Under current laws, boats can be parked on residential streets.</p> <p>Council can impound a boat trailer if it has been abandoned by giving the owner 28 days notice to remove the trailer.</p> <p>Owners who receive this order have typically moved their boat down the street or even returned it to the same spot an hour later.</p> <p>Please note, some people park their cars or caravans on local streets for extended periods of time without using them. This is the same situation as for trailers.</p> <p>It is not within Council's remit to purchase or hire land for boat owners to store their boats. Private facilities which offer this service already exist.</p>	Planning, Sustainability and Compliance	Complete

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	<p>Will Council please advise how they intend to increase our permeable/plantable areas and decrease the asphalt and concrete in our precinct and greater municipality?</p> <p>One of the stated aims of Waverley Council's strategic plan is to increase tree canopy by 30% by 2029 thereby diminishing the heat islands in the municipality.</p> <p>Will Council commit to converting No STOPPING areas at street intersections to gardens - as has been done at Tasman, Jackaman, Jacques, Consett - and protecting every tree and garden historically established within the street itself to support these strategic aims?</p> <p>Will the General Manager ensure that the traffic /kerbside & guttering and tree management officers are educated about these aims and willing to support them?</p>	<p>strips and is continuing to increase the number of street trees through additional planting.</p> <p>Council is continuing to increase permeability through streetscape upgrades such as in the Bondi Junction Cycleway, Glenayr Streetscape upgrade and the implementation of 40km/h zones in Waverley.</p> <p>Other locations for additional streetscape gardens are identified when streets and kerbs are undergoing maintenance.</p> <p>As well as the strategic goal to have tree canopy cover, Council has developed a street design manual to assist with modern, sympathetic and resilient gardens in its streetscapes. These gardens are designed to improve safety at intersections, provide water treatment, reduce flood impact and importantly increase greenery and tree cover. These strategic goals have led to the recent Rickard Ave raingarden, the Roscoe St raingarden, the Barracluff Ave kerb buildouts just to name a few.
