### **2: Open Forum discussion**

- What is the Council directive regarding dogs at Cafes?

Council regulations state that dogs are allowed at cafes but they must be a certain distance from food. This directive is not being followed by some cafes and it was suggested that Council remind Café owners of their obligations.

- Dickson Lane: Road surface in very bad condition and needs some urgent attention, motion regarding this matter to be sent to Council.

- Stormwater Drain –Belgrave Street

New kerb and gutters and drains have recently been constructed in Belgrave Street, some of these drains have been positioned incorrectly and need to be rebuilt. Liz to send a photo to Cr.Mouroukas

for his attention. The nature strips have been left in a scruffy way and need to be returned.

- Taxi rank at Grosvenor Street Bondi Junction

It has been requested that an all-weather covering be placed over the taxi rank in Grosvenor Street

There has to be an agreement between a few parties for this to happen and that does not seem likely soon.

### **3: Traffic Report**

**Preamble:** Cars are frequently parked in Alfred Street within 10 metres of the South east & North east corners of Darling Street. Visibility for cars turning from Darling Street into Alfred Street is obscure to

the extent that the corner is very dangerous. In addition a tree planted on council land on the north east corner of Alfred and Darling Streets is restricting visibility for drivers.

## **Motion 2**

Bronte precinct requests that Waverley Council erect No Stopping signs or paint yellow lines in Alfred Street at south-east and north east corners of Darling Street and trim the tree on the northeast corner.

Is Volley ball allowed at Tamarama Beach? The answer is yes according to council,

Much discussion took place at meetings (2006-2007) by many residents and reference groups regarding this subject and the consensus was that volleyball should not be allowed at the beach, it was agreed that this would not be permitted.

This suggestion to "***Permit ball games on the beach that are not part of a competition , and use temporary nets and soft balls.***" was put in the Tamarama Plan of Management by the consultants and adopted by Council in June 2007, against residents wishes.
