

## **Notes of the South Bondi Precinct Meeting**

### **Held on 30/11/2016 at Waverley Council Chambers**

The meeting opened at 7.30pm.

#### **Present:**

There were 7 residents incl. me & Counsellor Bill Mouroukas.

#### **Apologies:**

Counsellor Tony Kay

#### **Minutes of the previous meeting.**

There was no quorum at the March AGM. Notes for the discussions held at that meeting were distributed at the end of the meeting.

#### **Matters arising:**

The residents in Kenneth Street are progressing with their interest in underground powercables in Kenneth Street. The issue of underground wiring for lighting was raised. As maintenance of the lights would be paid for by Council the question arose what type of lights would be allowed by Council and whether guidelines existed.

**DAs:** No major DAs. Copies of DAs received were available for inspection. No notifications received during November.

#### **Traffic & Parking Report**

No issues were reported.

A resident raised the issue that she had received a fine for parking in an area which had had the usual No Stopping sign removed during the Sculptures by the Sea event. It was confirmed by residents present that the – apparently illegal – removal of signs was quite a common occurrence. She will seek advice how Council deals with these issues: fines & replacement of signs. Are records kept by Council when signs are replaced.

#### **General Business:**

A problem with building work impacting on a neighbouring property in Fletcher Street was reported. Counsellor Mouroukas and the Council compliance officer had visited the site. Counsellor Mouroukas outlined the steps available to the resident to seek redress.

Residents raised concern about the limited visibility when turning right from Kenneth Street into Alexander Street. The Precinct is requesting an update from Council in regard to improvement of safety & visibility of the intersection Kenneth and Alexander Street,
