Development News Da 534/2022 449 Bronte Rd. Bronte.

Sue Ritchie neighbour from 451 Bronte Rd. spoke to the meeting of her concerns re. the above development.

This was followed by MEET THE CANDIDATES for Coogee for the State election 2023.

The 3 candidates Celia Mosquera Informed Medical Options Party, Marjorie O'Neil Australian Labor Party, and Rafaela Pandolfini The Greens.
Each candidate presented for three minutes followed by questions from the floor.

Following the Meet the Candidates event the meeting continued with a motion concerning 449 Bronte Rd. This was proposed and passed unanimously.

Background

There was considerable concern expressed with Da 534/2022 at 449 Bronte Rd. because of its excessive Floor Space Ratio and the application to remove four trees, two of which are sited on the neighbours' property for which they have not been consulted.

That the Bronte Beach Precinct requests that Council reject development application DA-534/2022 regarding 449 Bronte Rd, Bronte, which is currently under assessment.
