



Waverley Heritage and Design Awards 2019

The Waverley Heritage and Design Awards recognise and celebrate contemporary design projects and the conservation and promotion of our heritage and history.

Established in 2006, the Awards promote and acknowledge projects that conserve heritage listed properties and heritage conservation areas. The Awards recognise heritage conservation and interpretation and excellence in contemporary design including public places.

This year, for the first time we will be recognising the efforts of an individual or group in our Contribution Award and will invite the community to vote in a People's Choice award.

The Awards

Residents, owners, architects, designers, project managers, builders and community groups are invited to nominate projects that meet the eligibility criteria outlined on the back of this form.

Winners will be announced at a special awards ceremony on 30th April 2019 and all shortlisted projects will form part of an exhibition at the Waverley Library Gallery which coincides with the 2019 Australian Heritage Festival.

Award Categories

Contemporary Design

Any contemporary project or study, including the design of public places.

Heritage

Any built heritage conservation project or study, or any adaptive reuse of a heritage structure.

- Alterations and Additions
- Restoration
- Infill/Adaptive Reuse

Contribution

This award recognises the efforts of an individual or group who have contributed towards conserving our heritage. This can include volunteers, professionals, organisations, community groups as well as events which showcase and promote our history, heritage and culture.

People's Choice

Nominations in all categories will be eligible for the People's Choice Award. Any member of the public can vote on this award during the exhibition at the Waverley Library Gallery, 2nd May – 23rd May 2019.

Entry Checklist

- Completed entry form – a project may be submitted in more than one category however separate entry forms are required for each
- Summary of the project (maximum of 350 words)
- Address judging criteria (maximum of 350 words)
- Before and after plans and photos (maximum of six images) all photos to be submitted at 300dpi



2019 awards and Commendations

Judging Criteria

Entries and shortlisted nominations will be judged by a panel. The criteria for the Contemporary Design and Heritage categories include:

Response to category: underlying principles and core ideas

People: innovation in design that satisfies the functions and needs of today

Place: excellence in creating places in a manner that responds to and enhances the significance of Waverley

Product: excellence in design and delivery with positive response to Waverley's built environment

The Contribution category criteria includes:

Response to category: Contribution to managing, conserving or promoting heritage and history in Waverley

Eligibility

The type of projects that would be eligible for the Awards include:

- new contemporary designed buildings as well as alterations and additions
- interior designs for public buildings, shops, offices, cafes and restaurants
- public domain projects or projects for privately owned spaces used by the public
- alterations and additions to heritage items, or places within heritage conservation areas
- infill development in a heritage conservation area
- conservation works such as restoration, reconstruction and adaptation of a heritage item
- maintenance of a heritage item or historic places within a conservation area
- community heritage projects and events
- historic studies, heritage interpretation and heritage promotion projects

Conditions of Entry

Entry is open to projects within the Waverley LGA that have been completed in the past three years (2016-2019).

Projects shortlisted in previous Waverley Council-run Heritage and Design Awards may be considered.

Each nominated work or project must have an individual entry form.

Owners' consent is required for all entries.

Access to the project site must be made available for judging if a property is shortlisted.

Each entrant understands and agrees that any photos or information submitted as part of an entry can be published and used in Waverley Council publications, future exhibitions and displays, Council's website and in media for Council, for the purpose of promoting the awards or heritage and design in general. Waverley Council will provide due acknowledgement.

Waverley Council takes no responsibility for the content of nominations. It is the responsibility of those nominating to ensure that all care has been taken to identify and acknowledge the contribution and work of all relevant parties.

The judging panel has complete discretion in the awards process and judges decisions are final. No correspondence will be entered into. The judges reserve the right not to give an award for each category.
