

## COLOUR CODE FOR PLANS

When plans are submitted for a development application, Council requires the **changes** to be clearly shown on the plans.

Council uses a standard set of colours so that no matter who deals with an application, they have an understanding of the works without referring to a legend.

Council requires four (4) copies of plans plus a CD to be submitted with any application, **coloured** according to the following list:

| MATERIAL                            | COLOUR ON PLANS |
|-------------------------------------|-----------------|
| Timber                              | Yellow          |
| Demolition                          | Orange          |
| Roof tiles                          | Light red       |
| Paving (tiles, terracotta)          | Light red       |
| Internal tiles                      | Purple          |
| Brick                               | Red             |
| Steel, galvanised iron              | Dark blue       |
| Aluminium                           | Dark blue       |
| Glass and glass bricks              | Light blue      |
| Concrete                            | Dark green      |
| Fibre cement sheets / cement render | Light green     |
| Sandstone and other natural stone   | Light brown     |
| Earth                               | Light brown     |
| Marble                              | Mauve           |
| Bituminous products                 | Grey            |
