

# Waverley's Profile of Young People (15-24 year olds)

In 2016, 6,120 young people (9% of the total population) were living in Waverley. Of these, 3.6% were 15-19 years old and 5.5% were 20-24.

## 76.6% are fully engaged in education and employment

80% of 18-24yr olds have completed year 12.  
24% attend high school, 5% TAFE and 28% university

3,120 (51%) work with more than half part time  
21% are volunteers which is higher than average

The most common industries are accommodation & food services, and retail (37.2%)

Young people found work close to home with

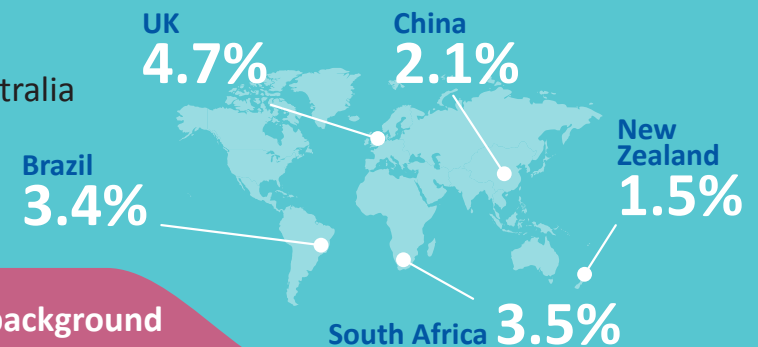
34% working locally

## Young people in Waverley

are more likely than the Sydney average to live away from home

Just over 50% lived with their parents as  
▶ couple families (43%) ▶ single parent families (13%)

17% lived in group households, almost double the Sydney average
