St Catherine's committee: CCC meeting held 18th Feb on ZOOM, mid September construction finishing; 15th May cranes to be removed, will block off Macpherson St; work has been starting too early 7 days per week, COVID lifted restrictions. Complaints about workers smoking in Leichhardt Lane, trucks idling, cracking appearing in building at 4 McPherson Street, idling cars picking up kids; next meeting late May. Monitor vehicles post construction aquatic centre and theatre with little or no on-site parking.

- 5. Pubs report: complaints by a resident, people exiting Charo, bad behaviour, has installed cameras and lights; Robin Hood ok except for overnight noise. Co-operative.
- 6. Community Hub (Shop 4) delighted with response and participation. Tuesday talks well received, 10-13 people every time. Robert Mills history through postcards, Brian Ellison historic context of wider Australian events; offers for further talks about Bronte House and School of Arts. Mobile Mayor at 1.30 pm next Tuesday; Council presence will be good too; asking for 3-6 month lease. Council want month to month. Mainly seniors coming in, want to broaden out.
- 7. DAs Phillip House, submission of objection made by CCV precinct; proposed demolition of nursing home with 67 beds to boarding house with 44 beds; objection mainly on grounds of loss of beds, and overdevelopment of the sites. Precinct to follow up with Member for Coogee, Dr Marjorie O'Neill regarding planning legislation allowing boarding house for aged care.
