1. Welcome and Acknowledgement of Country

Sharon was welcomed and thanked for attending. She gave an overview of works in progress relevant to Bondi Beach.

- Lights on Campbell Pde being replaced under warranty
- Repairs to skate bowl and balustrade
- Reapirs to playground water main completed
- Wheel stops in QED parking bays
- Biddigal and northern section of park behind playground herbicide spraying and re-turfing
- Contractor moved buildup of sand from beach back into water
- Delays with Geln Ayr due to replacement of Council owned poles
- Elecrtical upgrade to the Pavilion continuing
- Tenders out for Curlewis cycleway and streetscape

2024 scheduled upgrades

- Gould Lane Gould St Hastings
- Park Drive South/ Wairoa
- Hall St/ O'Brien

Dsicussion ensued about the importance of Bondi Beach being seen as a priority for upkeep and maintenance given its internatioanl significance. Areas of the parks and beach are neglected. Bondi Beach doesn't appear to be as well cared for as beaches in other municipalities e.g. Coogee and Manly.

Bondi Beach needs to be viewed, as stated above, as a very special location, and should be taken out of the queue and viewed as an entity requiring unique treatment.

South Bondi in particular is badly neglected, the parklands, the paths and stairs without adequate railings, the Norfolk Island Pines and the footpaths on the western side of Campbell Pde between Francis St and Lamrock Ave. This is the first place people alight from the buses bound for the beach.

It is noted that the footpath and lighting for Campbell Parade from Francis Street to Lamrock Ave will be affected by projected works on properties facing the street.

MOTION 1:

That Bondi Beach Precinct, having identified numerous unaddressed problems in the South Bondi Beach Park, urges Council to raise the priority of various major projects and maintenance works in this area.

4. Skate Park Toilets

Bondi Beach residents are concerned that these toilets were supposed to be installed before the Bondi Pavilion upgrade was finished to allow for the reduction of toilets in the Pavilion and to cater for the many young children who use the skate park.

8. Traffic problems in the Precinct

MOTION 2:

Bondi Beach Precinct requests that all traffic be prohibited from turning right when travelling: 1. North on Sandridge St Bondi Beach to cross Bondi Rd, heading towards Campbell Pd; or 2. East down Bondi Rd to turn across traffic in Bondi Rd to enter Sandridge St.

Submission:

The reason for this proposal is that this traffic presents a very real danger with frequently heavy and fast moving traffic travelling into or out of this steep bend. Such traffic is frequently travelling downhill at speed and includes buses, bike and cars, or is crossing into this intersection with heavy traffic moving in both directions along Bondi Rd.

The slightest mistiming could potentially result in a multiple vehicle crash with major damage, injury, and loss of life.
