# Waverley Council Acknowledgement to country

We pay respect to the Bidiagal and Gadigal people, who traditionally occupied the Sydney coast and the land and sea country of Waverley, and to Elders past and present. #### Introduction

It is recognised that trees are valuable for their contribution to environmental quality. "Significant trees" are those trees that make a major contribution to the everyday landscape and are therefore of special value to the community.

There are 121 trees listed on the Significant Tree Register. These trees were selected based on their cultural, historical, botanical, ecological and aesthetic values.

Significant trees are found in streets, parks and private property throughout the Waverley municipality and were nominated by the community and assessed by arborist, landscape and heritage consultants.

This document was originally produced in 1993, updated in 2012 and 2023 to include photos of the listed trees and criteria for significance. In the process of updating the Register, it was evident that some trees had died or been removed, and these trees have been reflected accordingly in the Register.

The listings are not final, and additional trees can be added and the Register will be subject to ongoing review and updates.

Importantly, it should be recognized that the value of those trees not listed on a Significant Tree Register is not diminished. All trees are valued and are subject to Council's tree management controls.

## **Protecting Significant Trees**

Waverley Development Control Plan (DCP) – Part B3 – Tree Preservation is the established mechanism for protection of all trees. The Significant Tree Register is an additional tool drawing attention to particularly valuable or

outstanding trees. To ensure the importance value of these trees a more detailed process is afforded to the trees for added protection. All trees listed on the Significant Tree Register will require development consent to either significantly prune or remove.

## Significance Assessment Criteria

An assessment of heritage significance endeavours to establish if and why an item is important and requires a methodical and consistent research approach. All potential listings on a Significant Tree Register should be subject to a Visual Tree Assessment and a determination of relative importance in terms of established criteria. The criteria for assessment are based on general principles outlined in the Burra Charter and on criteria from the Register of the National Estate. Since 2007, the Register of the National Estate ceased being a statutory listing; however, the assessment criteria it established remain valid. The criteria are applicable to all types of heritage places and items, be they natural, cultural, or Indigenous. However, the criteria used within a Register are adapted to be more tree focused.

The assessment criterion aims to differentiate between trees that have qualities of significance and those trees of lesser attributes and considers both natural and cultural qualities. Whilst some criteria may have a particular bias, heritage items, including trees, tend to have multiple values. Generally, for a tree to be considered for listing on a Significant Tree Register, it should satisfy at least two of the criteria, especially if the primary attribute is visual/aesthetic value. This limits the subjectivity of the nomination and assessment process.

#### The following five criteria is what trees will be assessed on:

#### Cultural, Social and/or Commemorative Values

 Highly valued by the community for reasons of strong religious, spiritual, cultural, educational, political or other social associations, including Indigenous culture and heritage

#### **Historic Values**

- Associated with a well-known public figure or group
- Reflects a specific era of landscape design
- Associated with a heritage listed place
- Forms part of a recognized historic garden or park

#### **Botanic/Scientific Values**

- High horticultural or genetic research/ educational value
- An important source of propagation stock, including specimens that are particularly resistant to disease or climatic extremes

#### **Ecological Values**

- Important for threatened flora, fauna, ecosystems, or natural landscapes
- Specimens of rare, threatened or locally uncommon species or ecological communities
- Provides a significant habitat for rare or threatened fauna
- Indigenous remnant trees that predate urban development. Significant remnant communities are not included in the Register – however, other smaller fragmented elements of natural heritage may be included

#### **Visual/Aesthetic Values**

- Situated within a very prominent location
- Outstanding for height, trunk circumference or canopy spread
- Highly visible and considered a landmark
- Exhibits an unusual growth form or physical feature, including unusually pruned forms
- Contributes significantly to the establishment of local character

# Responsibilities of the owner of a significant tree

The owner of a tree listed on the register is expected to:

- Properly maintain and preserve the listed tree
- Apply to Council for any routine pruning work (May require a tree permit or Development Application depending on scope of tree works)
- Submit an Arboricultural Impact Assessment report for any development application that may impact on the tree protection zone of a heritage or significant tree
- If proposed for removal, lodge a development application for consent, which must include a report from a consulting arborist


