UPCOMING LOCAL COUNCIL ELECTION



Waverley's Local Council Election is on **Saturday 9 September 2017.**

If you are enrolled on the Commonwealth/State electoral roll as residing in Waverley Council as at Monday 31 July 2017, you will be included on the roll for the Local Government (Council) election and voting is compulsory.

Election Day - Polling places are open from 8am - 6pm.

Early voting options - Pre-poll voting opens Monday 28 August at the Margaret Whitlam Recreation Centre in the Community room until 6pm Friday, 8 September. Postal votes must be received by the NSW Electoral Commission by 5pm Monday, 4 September.
