ACTION: It was suggested that a complaint be made to Compliance as the question was not answered specifically. Is the Tobacconist compliant?	This site operates under a CDC. NSW Legislation Under <u>Code SEPP</u> – Part 5 states: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(f) if the sign is illuminated— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) have its means of illumination, including any associated cables, concealed or integrated within the frame of the sign, and</li> <li>(ii) not be animated, flashing or moving, and</li> <li>(iii) comply with AS/NZS 4282:2019, <i>Control of the obtrusive effects of outdoor lighting</i>, and</li> <li>(g) if the sign is a business identification sign and is on land that is within a residential zone or within 50m of land that is within a residential zone and the sign faces the residential zone—only be illuminated during the following periods— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) if the hours of operation of the business identified on the sign have been approved—during those hours,</li> <li>(ii) if the hours of operation of the business identified on the sign have not been approved—between 7.00 am and 10.00 pm on any day.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Charing Cross does not have it's own signage controls. Recently there has been some improvement in this situation but Council there are still a number of situations where waste bins are causing an obstruction. Council will be liaising with businesses so that the presentation of waste improves, noting that businesses that require daily collection and have limited storage available means that there isn't always a straightforward solution.
