3	Matters Arising from previous meeting Nothing raised
4	Bondi post Dec 14, Bridge and Memorial The BB precinct acknowledged the profound and enduring impact the attack on Dec 14 th had had on the local community and extended its deepest sympathies to the families and friends of the victims. It was noted that Waverley Council will be honouring the 15 victims at the Council Meeting on 24 Feb 2026. Clr Merten provided an update on Councils responses including supporting numerous local Jewish organisations as well as the surf lifesaving clubs, where some of its members were the first responders Clr Merten also provided an update on the proposed Memorial as well as the restoration of the bridges which have reached their useful life. It was also mentioned that Council has removed the plans for the ½ basketball court from the north Bondi playground and instead it form part of the Skate Park Redevelopment.
5	Future parties on the Beach (Fuzzy) An update on the 2 events that were taking place on 20 th and 21 st of February. Discussion was had as to why fences needed to be erected so early and restrict local residents access to the parks.
6.	DA updates The status of 32 Campbell Parade was discussed and Clr Merten updated the precinct on the current status. There was discussion around some CDC developments on Warners avenue that appeared to be contradicted the local DCP. Clr Merten was going to follow up with DA team to determine if these are not aligned to local DCP laws.
7.	Roads and Traffic Discussion was had about traffic congestion at the Campbell Parade Roundabout and entrance to Queen Elizabeth Drive) during the summer weekends and how it impacts Hall st and Curlewis street. Not sure if this is a Waverley Council or state Government issue.
