COUNCIL OFFICER PROJECT BRIEFING:

Waverley Park Play Space Stage 2 Community Consultation.

Carl Nugent – Service Manager, Open Space and Recreation explained the project to attendees.

The concept design was considered by Council last week who endorsed the team to move to the next step to commence the second round of community consultation.

Community consultation will take place 5 August to 4 September 2022.

Information will be posted on our Have Your Say website, along with the online survey from Friday 5 August 2022.

TRAFFIC REPORT:

The Waverley Traffic Committee met on 23rd June 2022. The only item of significance to the BHP related to the City to Surf event which will take place on Sunday 14th August 2022. The WTC met again on 28th July 2022. The minutes of that meeting will be made public with the posting of the next Full Council Meeting agenda, expected to become available on Council's website on Friday 12th August 2022. Agenda items of significance to BHP were listed as:

TC/C.01/22.07 Resident Parking Scheme - Dalley Street and Paul Street, Bondi Junction - Area 22 Extension.

COUNCIL OFFICER'S PROPOSAL:

That Council:

1. Installs '2P 8 am–6 pm, Mon-Sat, Permit Holders Excepted Area 22' parking restriction in Dalley Street, Bondi Junction and along the western kerb line of Paul Street south of Bondi Road as shown in the report.

2. Retains existing unrestricted parking along the eastern kerb line of Paul Street.

TC/V.01/22.07 Festival of the Winds - Bondi Beach and Park - Special Event:
This event is to be held At Bondi Beach on 11th September 2022

The Member for Vaucluse, Gabrielle Upton has advised: "From Sunday 7 August, asphaltting will take place along Bondi Road, between Penkivil Street and Avoca Street, Bondi, to create a smoother road surface."

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS:

Lynda Hall reported she had not been made aware of any new Development Applications of significance to the Bondi Heights Precinct.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Soft Plastic Recycling Services:

Question from the floor raised in relation to 'Recycle Smart' Cr Fabiano reported Council was not currently considering any arrangement with 'Recycle Smart' due to operational costs considerations. Cr Kay reported that at the Council meeting held on 19 July 2022, Council resolved:

"That Council, as part of its commitment to Plastic Free July:

1. Investigates the establishment of a soft plastic, textile, batteries and e-waste, used and unused electrical goods recycling collection service by Council.
2. Provides enhanced community education on the options for recycling waste of this type.
3. Receives a report at the November Council meeting with the outcomes of the investigation and options for proceeding with implementation."
