# Summer Reading Club Terms and Conditions:

Your contact information will be retained by Waverley Library to be used only for the purposes of this program.

Please retain a copy of any works submitted from the activity pack you wish to keep e.g. book reviews, artwork etc as these items will not be returned.

Submission of an entry is deemed acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

## 1. Entry eligibility

- Entry is open to Primary School aged children
- To enter you must have a Waverley Library card number
- Each entry is for the individual and not group and/or household

## 2. Entry details

- Entrants must sign up with their details either via the Waverley Library webform or in person at the library.
- To be in the draw for a prize, participants must have entered at least one entry form.
- Participants must have parent or guardian consent/permission to become a participant in the Summer Reading Club.
- All fields in the sign-up form and entry forms must be complete.
- All entries must be submitted by close of business Monday 30th January 2023

## 3. How to enter

- Entrants must first register for the Summer Reading Club with their library card either online through the library website or in person at Waverley Library.
- For each book read the participant is to fill out a reading entry form and place it in the entry box at the Children's Library.
- Participants can enter as many entry forms as they wish provided each log is for a different book read.
- Books read must be from the Waverley Library collection.
- The term "Books" is to refer to any book read including Picture books, Readers, Fiction, Non-Fiction, Graphic Novels, E-Book.
- All fields of the entry form must be completed.

## 4. Prizes

- There are 3 prizes, 1 major prize of a \$100 book voucher and 2 runner up prizes of a \$50 book voucher each.
- The winning entries will be drawn randomly from the entry box on Tuesday morning, 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023.

## 5. Announcement and distribution


- Winners will be notified by phone Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023.




## DOTS & BOXES

## BANANA ICE CREAM SANDWICHES

(Always check with an adult first before using the oven and kitchen appliances.  
You will need a blender or food processor)

### INGREDIENTS

For the Biscuits

- 200g peanut butter (crunchy or smooth is fine)
- 175g golden caster sugar
- 75g dark chocolate, chopped into chunks
- 1 large egg

For the ice cream

- 3 bananas, peeled, chopped and frozen in advance
- 2 tbsp double cream
- 1 tsp vanilla essence



### METHOD:

#### STEP 1

Heat oven to 180C/fan 160C/gas 4 and line two large baking sheets with baking parchment. Put the peanut butter, sugar,  $\frac{1}{4}$  tsp fine table salt and chocolate chunks in a bowl and mix well with a wooden spoon. Crack in the egg and mix again until the mixture clumps together and forms a dough.

#### STEP 2


Break off chunks of dough (about the size of a cherry tomato) and arrange them, spaced apart, on the sheets. Press the cookies down with the back of a fork to squash them a little. (The cookies can be frozen for up to two months – to cook from frozen, add an extra 1-2 mins to the cooking time.) Bake for about 12 mins until golden around the edges and paler in the centre. Leave to cool on the trays for 5 mins.

#### STEP 3

Meanwhile, put the bananas, cream and vanilla in a food processor and blend until they make a thick ice cream. Scoop into balls with an ice cream






## SUMMER PLANS WORD PLAY
