

North Bondi Precinct Committee Minutes

Meeting held on Wednesday 26th February, on Zoom from 7:00pm

1 OPENING

- a) Present: Peter Quartly (Chairman), Rox De Luca, Ann Edvall, Peter McCue, Eva Prochazka, Helen Quartly, Justine Reef and Luke Stewart.
- b) Apologies: Joy Clayton, Rita Cole and Juju Kalek.
- c) Absent: Cr Dominic Wy Kanak, Cr Michelle Stephenson, Cr Margaret Merten (Council Meeting same night) & Joy Clayton.
- d) Opening: The Chairman welcomed everyone.

2. PREVIOUS MINUTES

a) Resolved the 7th November 2024 minutes be adopted as a true record of such meeting.

3. BUSINESS ARISING

a) Return and Earn Update

PQ chased up Kellie Sloane via email who promised a response – none provided to date. In our previous meeting Councillor Michelle Stevenson indicated she would like to follow this up.

Action: We request that the Return to Earn units are returned close to the original location behind the Pavilion – and that the response report needs to indicate this as ongoing.

b) Flyer Distribution

i) No flyer was produced prior to this meeting.

c) Flood Mapping of Municipality & Floodplain Management Committee

i) In Chair's report, there is the definition of flood, Federal Act, State Govt can't say anything else. The Committee promised to review it, and a meeting will be held in March which the Chairman will be attending.

d) North Bondi Terminus

- i) Council update report (as attached).
- ii) The meeting agreed to thank Council for the report, however, we remain concerned about how many people were involved in the early consultation. Can Council indicate what the statistics represent in terms of people? Justine Reef suggested we as a Precinct assist in local community engagement to support Council's efforts.

Post script: from Jessica 3/3/25:

Council received a total of 207 responses, 176 completed surveys and 31 additional written submissions.

iii) **Action:** We recommend Council organise a follow up meeting asap in the Pavilion and/or on Zoom to encourage greater active community consultation for residents for the next phase of the review. We also agreed that this extends to communicating with other local precincts: Dover Heights, Bondi Beach and Bondi.

m) The Bondi Mermaid

- i) Council advised there will be no change in location.
- ii) No update on the Mermaid to be placed in South Bondi.

n) Bidigal Reserve & Ray O'Keefe Reserve and Sam Fiszman Park:

- i) On Thursday 20th February, a meeting was held at the Bidigal reserve with Council staff and North Bondi Precinct residents
- ii) Eva discussed the multiple issues raised including Council staff indicating budgetary constraints in responding to maintenance of the reserve. A report by Jamie Mackay President of The Save Bidigal Reserve iii) Residents Action Group is attached.
- iv) Steve and Rebel will take the issues to the next Bondi Beach precinct.
- v) MOF interest of multiple issues were raised including safety concerns about the degraded wood railing at Ray O'Keefe reserve
- vi) Also discussed landscaping and general plans for the area including a toilet block and BBQ area.
- vii) We thank Council staff for organizing this meeting.
- viii) The Executive Committee of the Precinct will discuss further action requirements as there are safety and liability issues at stake.
- ix) **Action:** The meeting would like to view the architectural/landscaping plans proposed for this area and request that Council provide an outline and timeline of the management to remediate each reserve (Bidigal and Ray O'Keefe) and Park before anyone is injured.

o) Wallis Parade pooling towards Military Road

p) North Bondi Golf Course

- i) Justine Reef updated the Meeting about the situation, stating that Council has carried out temporary measures to prevent/reduce flooding to 146 and adjoining neighbours until it undertakes its permanent flood mitigation works on the Bondi Golf Course.
- ii) At present 146 is obtaining quotes to rectify the damage to their rear yard caused by the flooding. Council has agreed to pay once a few comparative quotes have been received.
- iii) It would be good to know when the permanent flood mitigation works will be undertaken by Council at the North Bondi Golf Course.
- iv) PQ: Asking Cr Michelle if there was any follow up
- v) Action: Cr Michelle Stephenson agreed to follow this up.

The matter was raised with Council. On 25 February by Luke.

A light pole has been installed, however, is not operating.

iv) Fogo trial.

The meeting discussed the trial and raised concerns about how soon trial residents will be contacted for feedback as the trial commenced on 10th October 2024. Meeting members explained that they found it hard to locate information about replacement bin liners on the Council website. The Meeting also noted that the original letter sent to residents about the FOGO trial was signed: Waverley Council without any team/staff member identified.

Action: Request Council provide a detailed progress report of the FOGO trial and timeline and when feedback/training sessions are occurring.

v) Council Chambers

Council is looking at asking for community feedback about using the existing building before major planning occurs.

Action: The Precinct is keen to provide feedback and ideas so can Council please provide details of the Chambers building.

vi) Ceramic street sculptures along Campbell Parade

We note that conservation work has started and keen to the Timeline and budget allocated.

vii) E-Waste

The Chairman has asked Council if they can follow Woollahra's lead and have a free e-waste collection. Jessica has advised their Sustainability team is actually investigating same.

viii) VANS AT THE BACK OF QED USED FOR SLEEPING

Cr Dove Frazer (16/1) has advised if they have a parking permit, they can do so with immunity. And in NSW it is not illegal to sleep in a car overnight.

ix) COMMUNITY JUSTICE CENTRES
