What is a floating boundary?

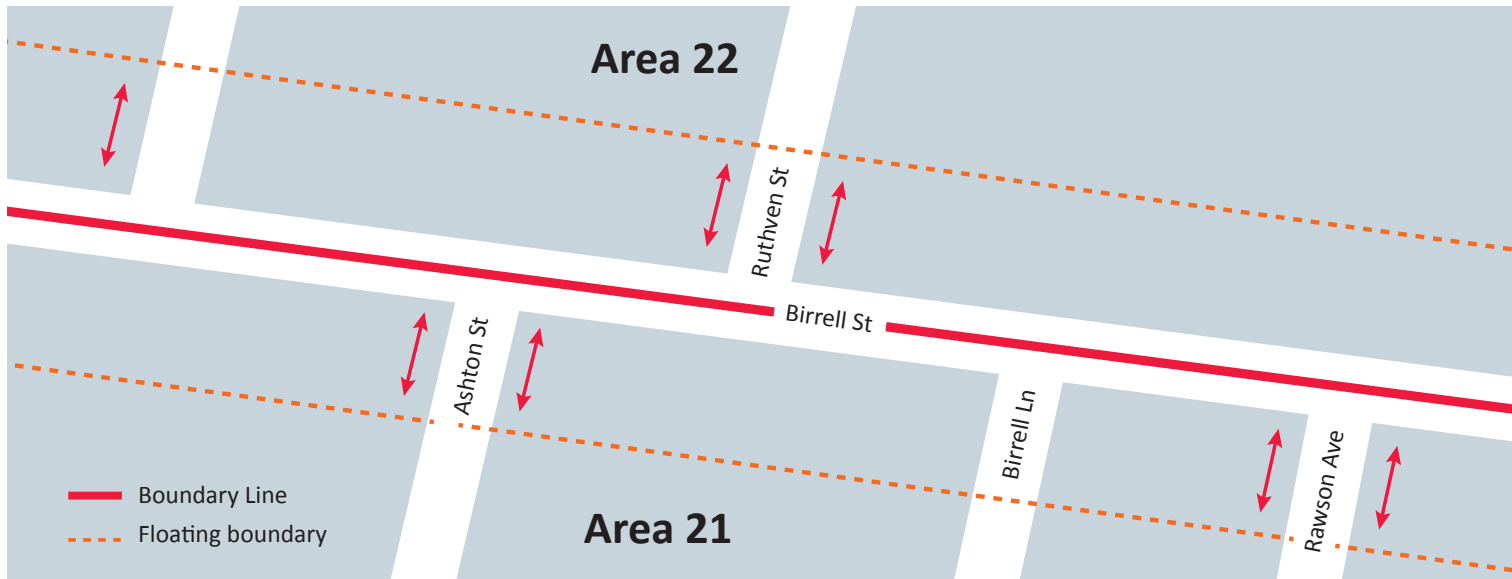
A floating boundary is a section of road where residents from two or more parking areas can use their permits. Floating boundaries will be located on both sides of the road where boundaries meet and will extend for approximately 50 metres into adjoining

streets. Signs will indicate what area numbers are valid in these sections of road, e.g. 2P Permit Holders Excepted Area 21 & 22.

Please note: In some circumstances floating boundaries cannot be implemented because of other road conditions in the area, such as bus zones or no stopping area.
