Contract for Administration of all Elections, Council Polls and Constitutional Referenda within the 4 year period, specifically the 2016 Local Government Election. As the 2016 Local Government Election did not occur in Waverley due to the proposed amalgamation with Woollahra and Randwick councils, the Contract remains valid for the scheduled 2017 Local Government Election.

6. The estimated amount payable to the contractor under the contract

\$357,206.30

7. A description of any provisions under which the amount payable to the contractor may be varied

Contract allows for the Electoral Commissioner to vary the costs that it charges Council for the administration of the 2017 Local Government Election.
