# Simple Worm Farming Guide

Please feed a balanced diet of 50% green materials (those high in nitrogen) and 50% brown materials (those high in carbon)



#### **Green materials**



Most fruit and vegetable scraps



Crushed eggshells



Coffee grounds, tea leaves and plastic free tea bags

# **Brown materials**



Dry leaves



Shredded newspaper and cardboard



Toilet rolls



Straw and hay



Egg carton



Coconut coir

If your system starts to smell or appears too wet, add more brown materials.

# **AVOID OR IN SMALL AMOUNTS**

#### In small amounts



Carbohydrates like cooked rice, pasta and bread

#### **Avoid**



Citrus and pineapple



Garlic and onions



Ginger and chilli



illi Meat, seafood and bones



Dairy



Cooking oils



Fresh grass clippings



Plastic or plastic coated products

#### Step 1:

Add your food scraps.
Only feed the worms
as much as they eat,
give them some time to
breed and gradually start
feeding them more.

# Step 2:

Add equal amount of dry, brown materials.

# Step 3:

Worms need air! Every now and then, give the worm farm a stir with a gardening tool.

# Step 4:

Cover your worms with a worm blanket, old cloth, shirt, towel or damp newspaper. Secure the lid and you're good to go!
